Requirements

Internships are full-time - 5 days a week, with occasional Saturdays depending on events, working from 9 am to 5 pm. We generally ask for a minimum commitment of 3 months from start to end of the school term. If this is not possible, let us know and we can discuss alternatives.

All Interns are expected to speak fluent or good conversational English.



Remuneration

Interns do not receive a stipend.

Accommodation

We do not provide accommodation for volunteers but we have several partners that we can recommend should you require it.

Transport

Interns are responsible for organizing transport to and from the schools. For Lavender Hill we recommend the train to Steenberg. For Khayelitsha we recommend driving or car-pooling with other interns and volunteers.



Steps to Become an Intern

Submit your **internship application** and we will respond within 5 working days to schedule a brief phone or Skype call.

If we're both happy at this stage, we will then schedule an interview with the relevant supervisor.
