DIRECTOR'S REPORT

As the founder and leader of Earthchild Project, 2022 was the most significant year to date since the organisation's inception 16 years ago. It was a year marked by challenges and crises, as well as great wins and achievements.

The pandemic had far-reaching consequences in the communities we serve, with increased unemployment, gang violence, and substance abuse, adversely affecting the well-being of our children and teachers. As a result, our team's experience working in the schools this past year was exceptionally challenging

In addition, 2022 was particularly difficult due to the reduced capacity of donors, and we therefore spent much of the year trying to close our funding deficit. One often hears that out of a crisis comes innovation and creativity, and this was indeed the case for ECP!

We reached out to ask for help and were overwhelmed with gratitude when several of our donors, who we have forged long-term relationships with, stepped in to offer additional support to keep our projects afloat.

Another exciting outcome was the registration of Earthchild NPO in Germany, which was formed by a small group of our dedicated German supporters and ambassadors.

The intensity of the year prompted me to re-evaluate my role in the organization and its sustainability. This process was invaluable, leading to a renewed personal conviction and commitment to the work we do and to the growth of our reach and impact.

During the Santam Women of Future award entry process, one of the questions posed to me was "what qualities are most important to do this work?" My answer was "passion and resilience" - two qualities that were definitely required for 2022, and two qualities that the ECP team embody. I feel immensely proud that we overcame the challenges we faced, and if anything, came out the other side, with renewed strength, clarity and passion. Thank you to everyone who supported us along the way.

Janna's incredible leadership and dedication to the organisation's mission were recognised externally by the broader community when she received the Santam Women of the Future award, which is awarded to an entrepreneur who is making a real difference in her community.

Over the past sixteen years, the Earthchild Project has impacted the lives of thousands of children. Some of the earliest participants are now part of the Earthchild team, which is a testament to the project's resilience, value, and inspiring impact on so many lives.






